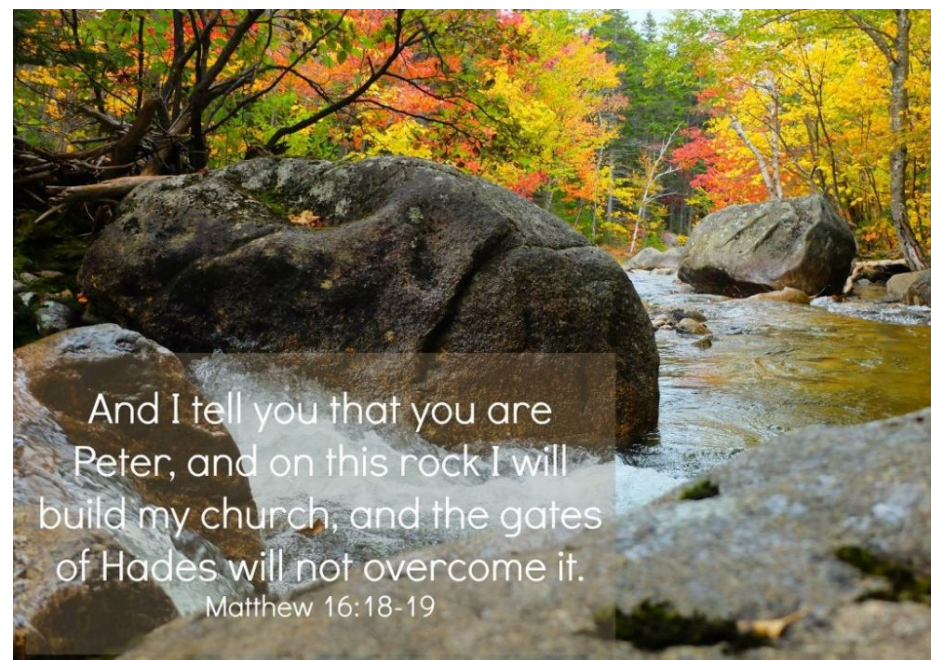

### Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

**Evening Prayer** is held twice a week over ZOOM, Tuesdays and Thursdays, at 18.15. The ZOOM link is accessible via the church website -> worship -> weekday services. All are welcome!

There will be **no morning prayer** on **Tuesday 11 August** due to absences.

**Prayer Ministry:** Christ Church hosts a Prayer Ministry. If you are interested in joining the Prayer Ministry speak to Andrew Rooke. Any prayer requests given to the group are treated in strictest confidence.

**Baptism and Confirmation:** Are there teenagers or adults in the congregation who wish to be baptised and/or confirmed? They should come forward and make themselves known to the Chaplain, or email the church office. Confirmation is a Christian service where individuals who have been baptized, typically as infants, publicly affirm their Christian faith, and commit to living as followers of Jesus Christ. It affords an opportunity to confirm the promises made at baptism and to become a full member of the church. During the service the bishop prays over them, while simultaneously laying on his or her hand on the individual(s).

**Six O'clock Services (SOS)** takes a break in the summer, resuming once more on 6 September.
