Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

Please **do not park** in the church garden / car park on the morning of **June 29**, as the trees will be trimmed by a maintenance company at that time.

Andrea Bianchi will be having his **ordination** service conducted in Brussels on 28 June at 10.30am local time; this will be broadcast via ZOOM and later recorded for viewing on YouTube. For the link, please see the weekly email, or drop an email to the church office.
