Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

Spring forward! The clocks will move forward one hour at 2.00am on Sunday 29 March. If you use an analogue clock, please prepare for the hour change.

The Church of England is hosting **Synod** for young voices (orientation evenings) for **young adults** (18 – 25). To sign up, please scan the QR code on the poster in the church porch or church centre.

This week **Youth Group** will learn about 'Jesus raising Lazarus to life'. Next week, Youth Group will learn about Palm Sunday.

If you would like the opportunity of having Sacramental Rite of Reconciliation (commonly called **Confession**), please speak with Revd Ádám Bak or email the office.

Lent groups occur weekly Tuesdays at 19.00 over zoom, Wednesdays 10.30 at the church centre, and Thursdays 19.00 at a church member's apartment.

The **Annual Chaplaincy Meeting (ACM)** is on **22 April**. Registration on the **Electoral Roll** enables you to attend the ACM, to vote on church matters, and to stand for election to the church council. The **deadline** for submitting a form is **8 April**.

The installation of Sarah Mullaly is on Wednesday 25 March, the Feast of the Annunciation.
