Children, Young People, and Adults

If you have concerns about an individual person's physical, sexual or emotional well-being, it is **your** responsibility as an individual to seek advice and support from the Christ Church Safeguarding Officer and/or Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser.

Clergy, Churchwardens, or Other Church Officers Any safeguarding concerns or allegations about anyone in a Chaplaincy role must be immediately reported to the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser.

A Member of the Congregation

Any safeguarding concerns or allegations must be immediately reported to the Christ Church Safeguarding Officer or the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser. Be assured that all matters will be dealt with as confidentially as possible by the Church, and reported to the police and/or social services as required, in order to protect those who are vulnerable from harm.

The Safeguarding Officer(s) will contact the appropriate authorities and manage the response.
