Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are baptised and communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

This week's image on the front cover is of a painting by Mattia Preti dated to 1660/65. It hangs in the Kunsthistorisches Museum Wien KHM, Room VI, and is inspired by John 20.24-29. 'Thomas, one of the disciples is invited by Jesus to convince himself of the reality of the physical/material dimension of the resurrection (the Easter banner is visible) by seeing and touching His wound. Static elements are combined in such a way as to create an unsettled image - Christ radiating light is facing the believer head-on - combining the dramatic narrative with the disciples' wonder and awe.'
