Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. **The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops.** If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

The next meeting of the **Reading Group** will be on Thursday 16 May at 19.00 on Zoom. The book is *The Bell* by Iris Murdoch.

On 8 May, the Eve of Ascension Day, there will be a concert in the church given by the **Joint Male Voice Choir** from Yorkshire in support of the paediatric cancer unit at the St Anna Children's Hospital in Vienna.
