Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing.

The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

The sign-up sheet for providing **Coffee** after the 10.30 service is found in the church centre.

The **Six O'clock Service** is taking a summer break. Services resume on Sunday 8 September 2024. There will be a service of Evening Prayer with Hymns on Sunday 1 September at 18.00.

Kids' Church is also having a summer break. We return Sunday 1 September with a Family Service.

After today's 10.30 service Diana will be putting out a selection of **summer reading books**. Please have a look and see if there are any you want.

This year the **Chaplaincy Outing** will take us to **Berndorf in Lower Austria**. The programme for the day is in planning.
