Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing.

The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

There will be a service of Evening Prayer with Hymns on Sunday 1 September at 18.00. The Six O'Clock Services start again on 8 September. Corin is looking for volunteers to help with reading, welcoming and food.

Kids' Church returns on Sunday 1 September with a Family Service.

This year the **Chaplaincy Outing** will take us to **Berndorf in Lower Austria**. The programme for the day is in planning. It will include a tour of the city, a visit to our sister church and a meal on the way back to Vienna. Will there be a quiz, I wonder?
