### <u>Annual Church Meeting: 2 September, 19.00</u> To members of the Electoral Roll:

You can nominate candidates for churchwardens, council members and archdeaconry representatives using the forms that will be displayed in the church garden (not the church porch as in previous years) after every 10.30 Sunday service during August. If you are not coming to 10.30 services at the church, you can ask someone who is attending one of those services to write down your nomination on the relevant form in the garden on your behalf. All nominators and nominees will be contacted before the ACM to confirm, in the case of nominators, their intention to make the nomination and, in the case of nominees, their willingness to serve.

#### To all congregants at Christ Church:

To attend the ACM, make a nomination or stand for election, you need to be a member of the electoral roll. To apply for membership, you can fill in a form (available in the church and centre) and hand it to Alexander Rösch (Electoral Roll Officer) or a member of the clergy, or send it by post it to the office. All forms must be received by Alexander or the church office by 15 August. If you are already on the electoral roll (i.e. if you were admitted in time for last year's ACM or thereafter) you do not need to complete another form.
