Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

The **Six O'clock Service** will take a break after 22 December and return Sunday 12 January. The last meeting of **Kids' Church** will be the Nativity Play on 15 December. We return on Sunday 12 January.
