Advent Meditations

Tuesday 15 December at 1900, the last of three Advent is the season of waiting. We are told to wait for judgement, for righteousness. We are told that one age will come to an end, and another one will begin. We are told that darkness will ultimately yield to light. These short, 30-minute meditations have two main purposes. First, to give some form to the formlessness of our Advent waiting: the three sessions are entitled 'Stars', 'Rain' and 'Voice'. Second, to offer some simple tips for our own individual spiritual practice in the form of meditative exercises around the three chosen themes. Each session concludes by saying Compline together.
