Holy Communion from the Common Cup

The common cup has been restored symbolizing our unity in Christ. Intinction (*dipping the bread into the wine*) is **NOT permitted for hygienic reasons and as directed by our Bishops**. If you feel uncertain about drinking from the chalice, continuing to receive the bread only is acceptable. Remain kneeling until the wine has passed. Should you have an active respiratory infection of any sort, we ask that you exercise caution and refrain from the cup.

Three **Lent groups** will be held this year: Tuesdays at 19.00, Wednesdays after the Eucharist at 10.15 (both in the church centre) or Thursdays at 19.00 in the 22nd. The word Lent comes from the Old English word *lænct*, meaning “lengthening (of daylight hours) (or, less literally, ‘spring’ or ‘springtime’).” “At its simplest, Lent is a season where you commit to a deeper holiness and more vibrant discipleship.” George Sinclair.
