

Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

The rescheduled **Soundings** session on the Franciscans being led by Frank Sauer will take place on Tuesday 28 January at 19.00 in the church centre.

During February the Revd Dr Michael Dormandy will lead three seasons on **the Nicene Creed** as the Church marks the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea at which the creed was agreed. The dates are the following three Tuesdays: 4, 11 and 18 February at 19.00 hours in the church centre.

Jennie Ratcliffe will be making jams and marmalades for the Church again. Please could you start collecting **jam jars** for her. No large ones or very small ones please. Just those containing 300 - 400 grams and please clean and if possible without labels. Many thanks.

In the coming months **The Electoral Roll** will be completely revised.
