URGENT REMINDER TO ALL UK RESIDENTS IN AUSTRIA Make sure you are in the process of applying for your Article 50 EUV Card. This is necessary for all British citizens living in Austria **no matter what residency status you may already hold**. According to British in Austria of the 11,529 British residents in Austria only half have registered for the Article 50 EUV as of 31 May. We cannot stress enough that this is necessary to be done by 31 December 2021. There are only 6 months left so please don't leave it to the last minute. SEIZE THE DAY and DON'T DELAY
