Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are baptised and communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

Outing to Znojmo, Czechia: Sign up for this year's outing now. We depart by bus at 9.00 in the morning. A joint dinner is in the planning back in Vienna. In Znojmo we will have a guided tour of the city, explore the city underground fortifications, walk along the river, hold a service <u>and have time</u> to explore the city on our own.

Prayers for the sick and the departed in July. If you would like a name added to the weekly prayer list email the office or give the name to Michael before the service.

Baptism and Confirmation: Are there teenagers or adults in the congregation who wish to be baptised and/or confirmed in the autumn? They should come forward now and make themselves known to the Chaplain. Confirmation date: **Sunday 12 Oct, 16.00.**

Confirmation is a Christian service where individuals who have been baptized, typically as infants, publicly affirm their Christian faith, and commit to living as followers of Jesus Christ. It affords an opportunity to confirm the promises made at baptism and to become a full member of the church. During the service the bishop prays over them, while simultaneously laying on his or her hand on the individual(s).

In the autumn Christ Church is hosting the **Eastern Archdeaconry Synod** from 9-12 October. If you are interested in helping with some aspects of the catering contact the Social Committee. There is much to do and we want to give the synod members a warm welcome and a good time.

The Chaplain is on leave to 31 July. During this time the Revd Dr Michael Dormandy will celebrate the Sunday morning services. All other weekday services continue as normal. Phone and emails will be monitored while the church office is closed.

The **Six O'clock Service/Evensong** takes a break over the summer holidays. We return on Sunday 7 September with Evensong.
