Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

The **Six O'clock Service** will be taking a summer break beginning again on Sunday 8 September 2024.

There will be a service of **Evening Prayer with Hymns** on Sunday 1 September at 18.00.

The chaplain's summer reading:

To better equip myself and to have something to recommend to those who are searching or are willing to reconsider their objections to Christian belief I intend to read two books over the summer by **Timothy Keller**, who died last year. He has been an inspiration to many a contemporary Christian.

The first is the Making Sense of God, 2016 (assumes little), and the other is The Reason for God, 2008 (provides good answers with an attractive presentation of the Christian faith; assumes more). My reason is that last summer I had a few conversations with in-laws about weighty matters including faith. One of my interlocutors asked for books to read. I always struggle to recommend books... The Keller books have been recommended to me. I will make a start! I invite you to make them a part of your summer reading as well. After the summer I will be happy to meet with anyone one to one who does choose to read one or other of these books to discuss themes and explore questions.
