### Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are baptised and communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

**Baptism and Confirmation:** Are there any teenagers or adults in the congregation who would want to be baptised and/or confirmed in the autumn? They should come forward now and make themselves known to the Chaplain.

Looking to Jesus the pioneer of our faith - Heb 12.2

The photo on the front cover is of a section of an altarpiece in Siena, Italy. It depicts saints and archangels gathered around God's throne. It shows how the saints look to Christ, whereas the archangels keep watch. This is captured by the archangels not looking to Christ as the saints are rather they look left and right.
