# **Concerning Receiving Holy Communion**

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

Our **Archdeacon**, The Venerable Leslie Nathaniel, will be visiting Christ Church over the weekend of 14-16 June. At this time six children will receive First Communion, Frank Sauer will be licensed as Reader and The Revd Dr Michael Dormandy will be licensed as Assistant Curate.
