Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. **The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops.** If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

On Saturday 9 March there will be a reading of **Mark's Gospel**. We will meet at 10.00 for a 10.15 start. This is an opportunity to sit together and hear the narrative as Mark presents it. We will be reading from the New Revised Standard Version (Anglicized).
