Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is no longer possible for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

Sunday offerings/collections For those without cash at hand it is possible to make a cashless donation via the card reader at the back of the church. Speak to the sidespersons and welcomers for assistance if required.

The pre-pandemic tradition of the **Christ Church Quiz** at the Readings' house is being revived this year. The date is **Friday 25 October from 6 p.m**. Those who are aware of the need of prayer for healing in mind, body or spirit are encouraged to attend the **Service of the Laying on of Hands** tonight at 18.00. This service also sees the return of the Christ Church **Jazz Band** to the Six O'clock Service.
