**Reading Group** - *Ubik* by Philip K Dick, Wednesday 20 November at 7pm on Zoom.

**The Letter to the Hebrews** provides encouragement as well as five solemn warnings. These are the dangers of neglect (2:1-4), unbelief (3:7-4:13), spiritual immaturity (5:11-6:20), failing to endure (10:26-39), and finally the danger of refusing God (12:25-29).

#### Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted for hygiene reasons as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.
