Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptized persons who are communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. **The practice of intinction** (dipping the bread into the wine) **is no longer possible for hygiene reasons** as directed by our Bishops. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup, receiving the bread only is acceptable.

The **Six O'Clock Services** are followed by food and fellowship. Sign up to help with the service or provide food. Rota sheet found in the church centre.

The **Reading Group** meets on 2 October at 19.00 on Zoom to discuss *Kairos* by Jenny Erpendeck.

The Harvest Festival is Sunday 6 October. The church will be decorated on Saturday 5 October in the morning should you wish to help. Each year we make a collection of food items for the soup kitchen of the Missionaries of Charity, Mariahilfer Gürtel. Tin food or bags of rice are helpful. If you cannot bring food but would like to help you can add an envelope with your donation to the food donations and we will pass it on.

The **crypt** (room downstairs at the back of church) is again available for use. If your child needs a break feel free to use the space. There is a speaker in the Holy Spirit chapel so you can follow the service. Would anyone be interested in providing a creche there during morning services?

Sunday Bible Study will resume on Sunday 6 October. The Bible study is held in the crypt beginning at 9.40.

Do you have a pet or know someone who does? The **Animal Blessing Service** is on Saturday 5 October at 16.00. Dogs, cats, hamsters and even snails have made an appearance over the years.

Those who are aware of the need of prayer need for healing in mind, body or spirit are encouraged to attend the **Service of the Laying on of Hands** on October 13 at 18.00. This service also sees the return of the Christ Church **Jazz Band** to the Six O'clock Service.

Sunday offerings/collections For those without cash it is possible to make a cashless donation via the card reader at the back of the church. Speak to the sidespersons and welcomers for assistance.

AfricaNight is coming up on October 4. A wide ranging programme of activities is planned and food will be plentiful.
