Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are baptised and communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

Baptism and Confirmation: Are there teenagers or adults in the congregation who wish to be baptised and/or confirmed in the autumn? They should come forward now and make themselves known to the Chaplain.

For a good many years Christ Church has been helping out at and also financing a soup kitchen run by Diakonie: 's Häferl. If you would like to help out at the soup kitchen please send an email to the church office and we will forward your request to the organizers. Dates for the autumn are 20 September, 18 October, 22 November and 13 December.

It is a delight to be in the **garden** after the morning service, especially in the warm weather. Any help carrying things back to the centre afterwards is greatly appreciated. Whenever you leave please have a look around to see if anything can be taken back. Thank you!
